

ECU Health

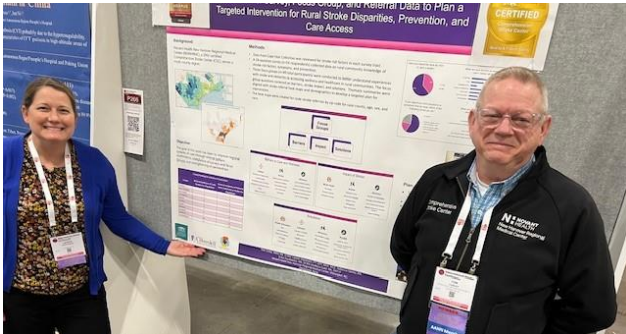
- ▶ Stroke Awareness Matters Program (SAM)
 - ▶ Post-Assembly Testing
- ▶ Collaboration with Business Analytics team
 - ▶ Implementation of the PowerBI platform
 - ▶ Identified a method to incorporate SDoH data into the stroke metrics and dashboards
- ▶ Support of Hospitals and Healthcare Entities
 - ▶ Those serving lower-resourced communities in the 29-county ECU Health catchment area
 - ▶ To improve diagnosis, treatment, and care of stroke patients.



Novant Health

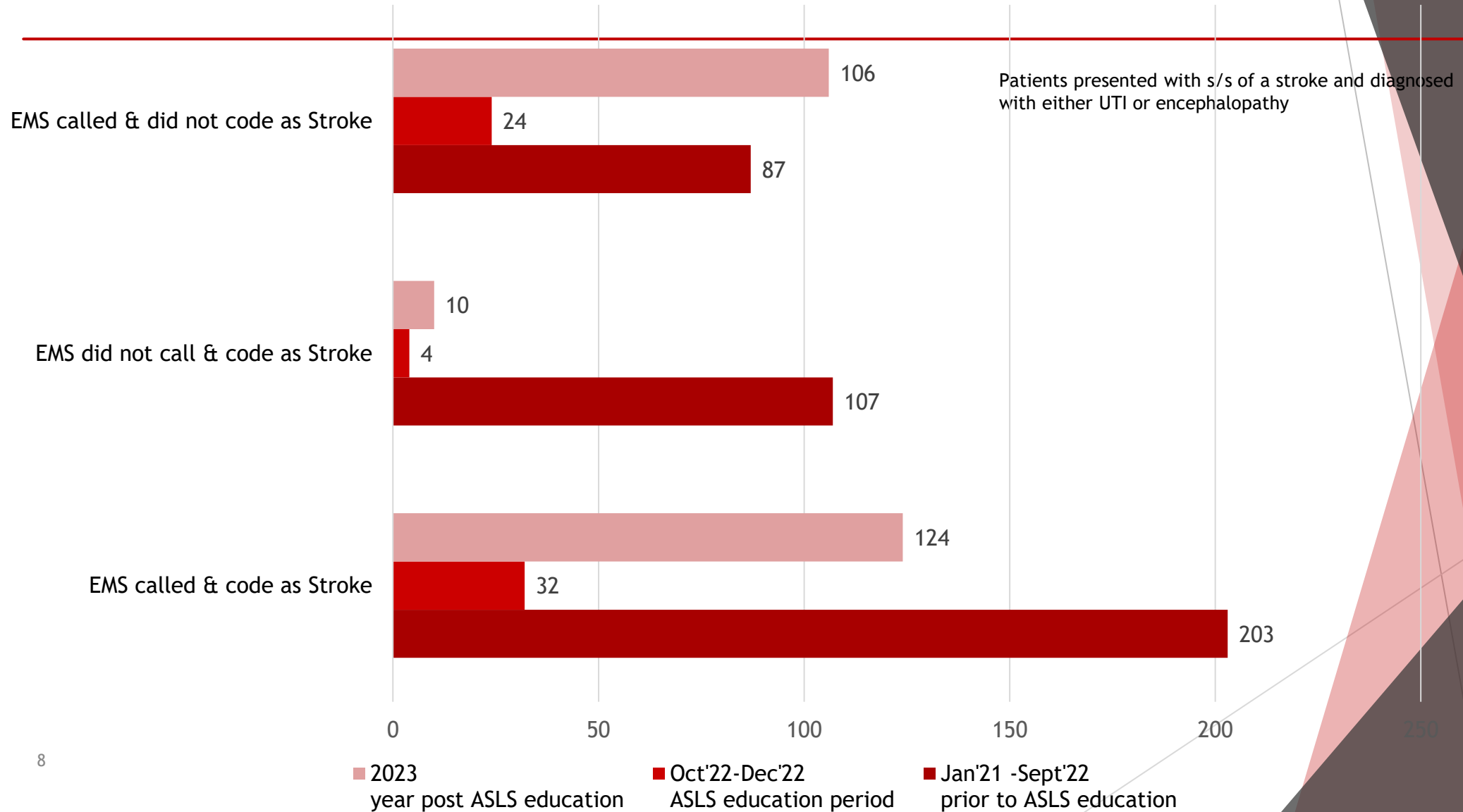
- ▶ Serving 17 counties across central, north-central, and south-eastern North Carolina
 - ▶ Greater Winston-Salem Market
 - ▶ Greater Charlotte Market
 - ▶ Greater Coastal Market
- ▶ Using data from:
 - ▶ EHR and special reports created with internal IT partners
 - ▶ Focus Groups held in rural counties served by the system
 - ▶ Community Events
- ▶ To address health disparities and improve patient care, and
- ▶ To convene targeted outreach and educational activities

Novant Health Accomplishments



- ▶ Poster Presentations at the International Stroke Conference February 2024
- ▶ Education of EMS personnel across the health system's reach including a report that:
 - ▶ Compares paramedics'/EMT abilities to identify stroke signs and symptoms between those receiving focused stroke continuing education and those receiving standard education, and
 - ▶ Assesses their knowledge and utilization of evidence-based resources regarding stroke care.
- ▶ Targeted Outreach and Education to more than 8,000 adults and youth across all three markets
