

# Coverdell Acute Stroke Program

- ➤ 3-year Cooperative Agreement ended June 30, 2024
- Projects
  - ECU Health
  - Northern Regional Hospital
  - Novant Health
- Stroke Coordinators' Monthly Meetings



## Coverdell Acute Stroke Program

- ► Division of Public Health awarded cooperative agreement for next round of Coverdell funding running September 30, 2024-June 30, 2025
- Cone Health also awarded Coverdell Stroke Program funding



#### Status of 2024 Action Agenda

- ► Endorse \$20 million (R) funding to expand tobacco cessation services and prevention>\$11,250,000 in nonrecurring funds in each year of the biennium from JUUL settlement
- Endorse recommendations of interagency committee to implement Tobacco 21>no bill introduced
- ► Endorse recurring funding for School Meals for All> \$3 million (R) each year plus \$3 million (N) in the first year to offset the reduced-price breakfast and lunch co-pays in schools participating in the National School Lunch Program and the School Breakfast Program
- ► Funding for the Expanded Food and Nutrition Education Program (EFNEP)>no progress

#### Budget Language Change or Technical Correction



Exempt NC Youth Tobacco Survey and the National Youth Tobacco Survey in the Parents' Bill of Rights Law>accomplished in 2024 short session
