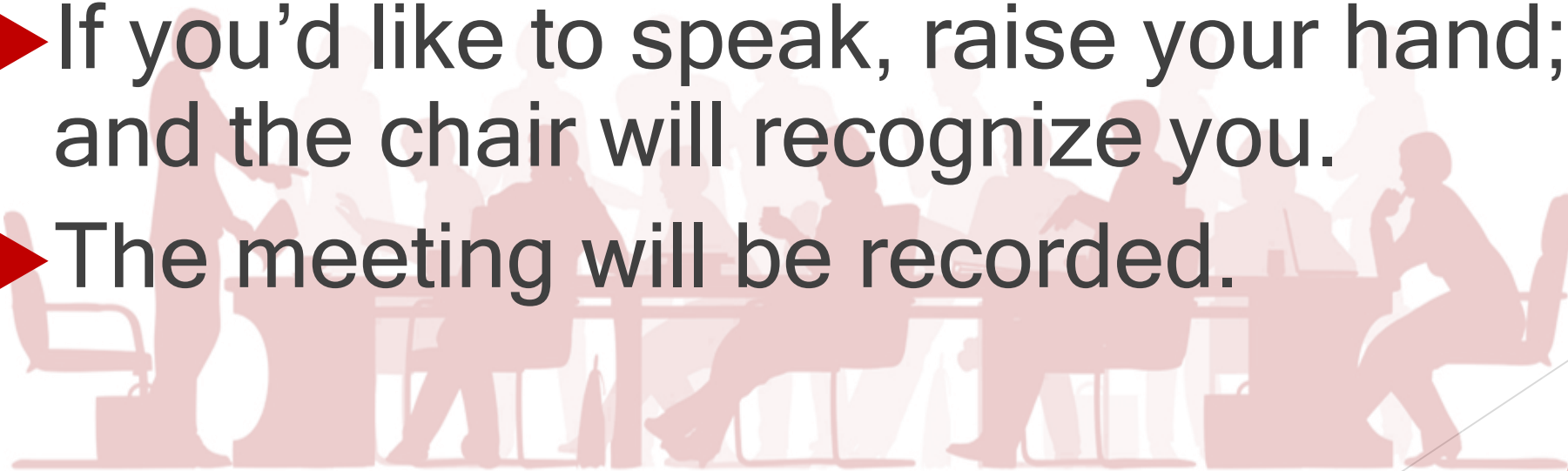

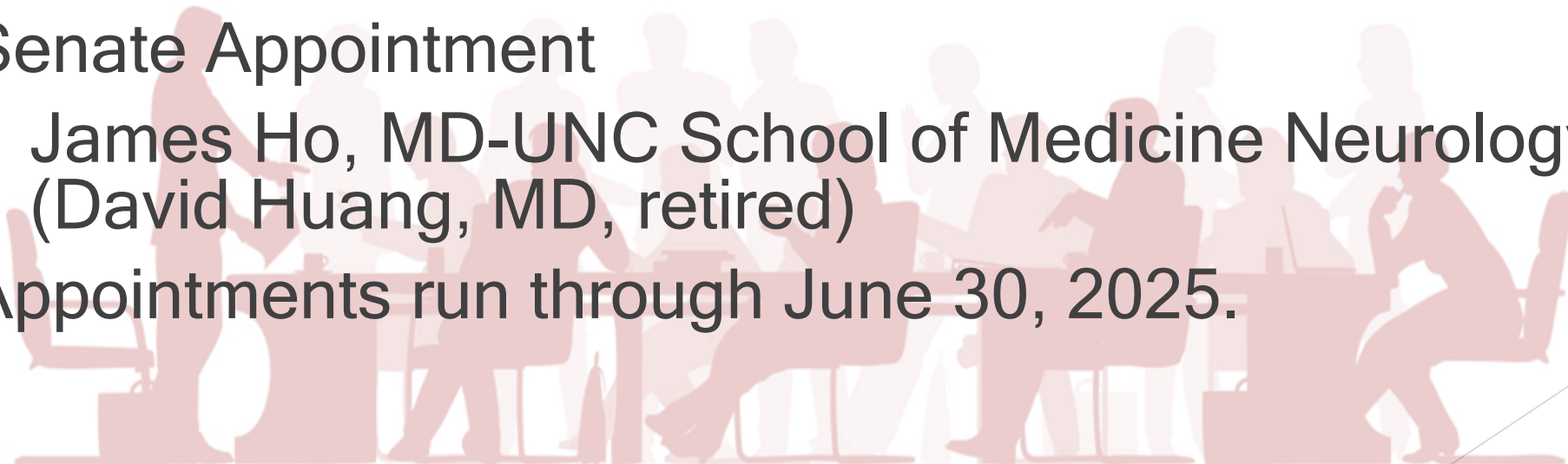

Stroke Advisory Council Report

- ▶ Collaborated with NC HealthConnex to add a Stroke Risk Factor interface in the Health Information Exchange (HIE) Stroke Registry
- ▶ Explored themes in these presentations:

 - ▶ Atrium Health's Telestroke Program and the Role of the Telestroke Nurse
 - ▶ Northern Regional Hospital's Stroke Program

 - ▶ IMPROVE Stroke Project Lessons Learned

Coverdell Acute Stroke Program

- ▶ 3-year Cooperative Agreement ended June 30, 2024
- ▶ Projects
 - ECU Health
 - Northern Regional Hospital
 - Novant Health
- ▶ Stroke Coordinators' Monthly Meetings

Coverdell Acute Stroke Program

- ▶ Division of Public Health awarded cooperative agreement for next round of Coverdell funding running September 30, 2024-June 30, 2025
- ▶ Cone Health also awarded Coverdell Stroke Program funding

Status of 2024 Action Agenda

- ▶ Endorse \$20 million (R) funding to expand tobacco cessation services and prevention > \$11,250,000 in nonrecurring funds in each year of the biennium from JUUL settlement
- ▶ Endorse recommendations of interagency committee to implement Tobacco 21 > no bill introduced
- ▶ Endorse recurring funding for School Meals for All > \$3 million (R) each year plus \$3 million (N) in the first year to offset the reduced-price breakfast and lunch co-pays in schools participating in the National School Lunch Program and the School Breakfast Program
- ▶ Funding for the Expanded Food and Nutrition Education Program (EFNEP) > no progress

Budget Language Change or Technical Correction

- ▶ Exempt NC Youth Tobacco Survey and the National Youth Tobacco Survey in the Parents' Bill of Rights Law>accomplished in 2024 short session
