

Funding Overview

- 5 year of competitive funds for 12 total awardees
- Funds are distributed annually based on federal obligations
- Awardees are required to submit annual fiscal reports
- There is no match requirement or cost sharing
- North Carolina DPH CCCPH's total award over 5 years is \$2,614,600


